Re: Round 49 Call for Applications for Forestry Futures Silviculture Projects

I am pleased to invite you to participate in the 49th call for applications for silviculture funding from the Forestry Futures Trust (FFT). We encourage you to submit applications for eligible work. The deadline for Round 49 applications is Friday, October 18, 2019.

Silviculture project application and budget forms can be found on our website (www.forestryfutures.com) under "Download Forms". We ask that you use *only* the most current version of these forms, as they appear on the site.

In order to streamline the process, an updated *Silviculture Project Application Guide* (September 2019) has been prepared for this Round and is provided with this letter (also available for download on our website). We recommend that you review the Guide for an understanding of the four project eligibility categories: Intensive Stand Management, Stand Rehabilitation of Natural Disturbances, Pest Control, and Insolvency. Information that the Committee requires and uses to evaluate projects and prioritize funding allocations is outlined in the Guide. You are encouraged to pay close attention to details found in *Considerations for Preparing an FFT Silviculture Application* that is located at the front of the Guide.

All information contained in your Project Application and supporting documentation is considered public information subject to the application of the Freedom of Information and Privacy Act R.S.P. 1990. c. F. 31, and is collected under the authority of the Act.

A submission containing incomplete information or in which key elements are missing will be returned to the applicant. Some opportunities for revisions may be provided on a case-by-case basis. Each applicant will be advised, in writing, of the Committee's decision by November 11, 2019.
